This special fantasy freight train pays tribute to one of America's famous chocolate confectioners, Hershey's Chocolate Company of Hershey, PA. The company was founded in 1894 by Milton S. Hershey and has been in business continually since that time.

Micro-Trains originally advertised that there would be 12 cars in this series, each a separate monthly release. Because of undisclosed reasons they actually only produced seven of the twelve (six plus the caboose and the Life-Like engine) plus one special run, N-Scale Collector car before their license with Hershey Company expired. They did, however, release a packaged Hershey train set with some of the same cars but with different road numbers.
